1 RULES

- 1.1* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

2 ADVERTISING

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Regenboog class.

7* MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested.



8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the Circolo Vela Bellano upon registration.

9 VENUE

9.1 The race office is located at the following address: Circolo Vela Bellano, Viale Tommaso Grossi, 23822 Bellano (LC).

9.2 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour.

9.3 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

10 THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be a upwind-, downwind course, with spreader at the upper mark and gate at the downwind mark, and a downwind finish.

The diagram of the course will be shown in Attachment C of the Sailing Instructions, including the approximate angles between the legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12 SCORING

12.1* Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2**
- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 11 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races score excluding the two worst scores

13 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with the Dutch National Flag.

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the moorings.

15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

16 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.



17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. VHF will only be used for safety communication.

18 PRIZES

Helmsman and crew of the winning boat acquire the title "Como Century Challenge Champion". Helmsman and crew of the boats that are placed second, third, fourth and fifth acquire also event prizes.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 , Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

20 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

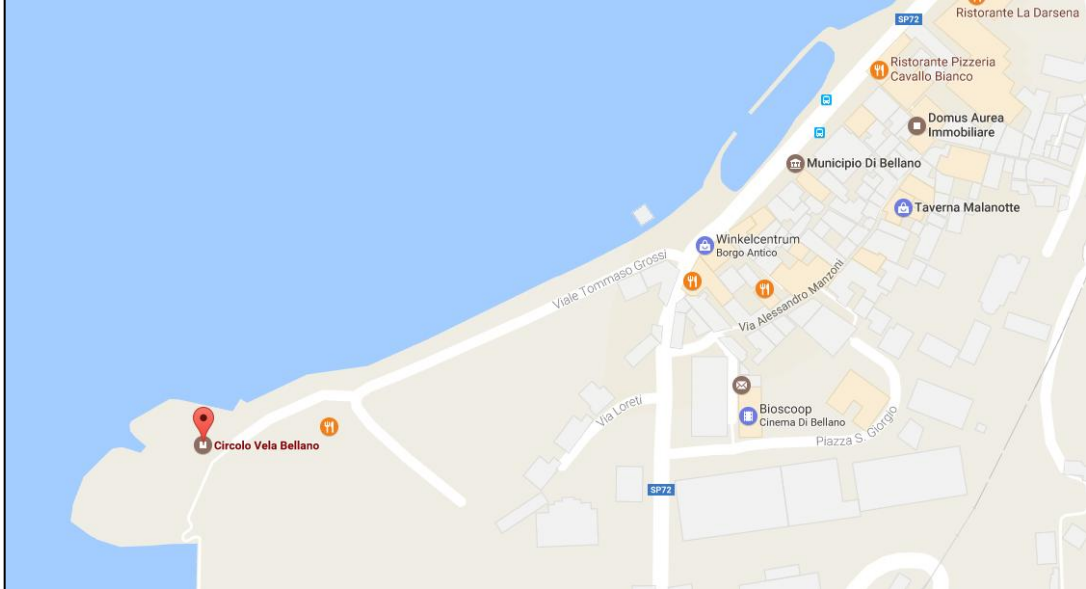
